REPORT

On the above time and date the Control Manager received a call from the owner of 18 Morganite Ave saying her domestic had reported a suspicious black male with a firearm in the yard via her cell phone.

Four Piranha cars were in the area at the time one in Leo Ave, one in Hardekool and one turning into Taurus Road from Drysdale Road and the other on Puttick Road near Aurora School. The vehicles converged on the house and two other Vehicles stopped vehicles leaving in Taurus Road corner Apollo and in Hardekool street. The domestics became very animated when seven vehicles raced into Morganite Ave (including three SAPS Vehicles)

Unfortunately all of the Officers arriving were not of any Seniority and Piranha Director Tim arrived some twelve minutes later after searching two vehicles in Hardekool Street.

Due to a number of in-appropriate questioning techniques used by a number of Officers both SAPS and Piranha Officers the stories ranged from 3 armed black males, to attempted rape, to a cash heist, to a house robbery and /or vengeance being brought to bear by the previous maid and/or to s care the new domestics away theft.

We have finally, after getting reports from all Officers on the scene managed to establish some form of genuine facts.

The domestic ladies heard the dogs barking for about 10 minutes and then looked out the lounge door (open and unlocked) to find two young black males outside who demanded cash from her.

She screamed in fright and the second domestic ran out the kitchen

area to phone the owner on her cell phone. This in its self is strange as both domestics know how to push panic buttons and these were tested just after the incident and came through perfectly in seconds The owner then phoned into our control and within thirty seconds vehicles were in Taurus, Hardekool and Puttick by Aurora School and the only black car that was reported by the maids was stopped and searched and had 3 Black males from the electricity Department in it.

The domestics were unsure how long it took them to get hold of Mrs Young, however had they pushed the panic the suspects would have not even have got out of Morganite before the Piranha vehicles would have arrived and detained them.

Thus far we are sure that two black suspects jumped the wall and released the unlocked gate motor. This was possibly for a theft of the gate motor but the suspects saw the house open and in likelihood moved closer to see what and who was at home.

This could have developed into a House Breaking or House robbery but as the did not manage to get hold of either of the Domestics and no firearms were seen at any time.

Real suspects as a norm do not threaten to rape a person whilst demanding cash and do not have the person under control as this threat in its self will normally set up a screaming reaction from the maid and this will disturb neighbours and this is not what they require.

With the open door most suspects would have taken the extra 20-30 seconds and at least taken TV, DVD, Kettle, Toaster CD's etc In this case nothing was removed that we are aware of and I can only put this case down as a Trespass case with the intention to commit a crime unknown to the state. The under current about the previous maid together with the demand for cash (from a Domestic?) and the threat of rape? gives rise for thought of some undercurrent from a previous maid

FOLLOW UP ACTION BY MANAGER

Patrols in the area have been increased as well as stop and go checks on all suspicious vehicles with assistance from SAPS giving us info on whether the car is wanted or not
