### HONEYDEW SAPS CRIME BRIEF: 31 OCTOBER 2011

Honeydew SAPS Precinct had a very good weekend with no TRIO crimes (Business robberies, House robberies and Hi-Jackings) reported from Friday the 28<sup>th</sup> of October 2011 until Monday morning the 31<sup>st</sup> of October 2011. Honeydew SAPS want to thank each and every member of the community for their assistance in the fight against crime. "Together we can and are making a difference in the fight against crime".

#### **Residents are asked to be on the lookout for the following suspicious vehicles:**

- Maroon Nissan bakkie with two occupants with firearms involved in business burglaries.
- White Toyota Venture with three occupants with firearms involved in house robberies.
- Silver Toyota Yaris involved in residential burglaries.
- Silver Mercedes Benz with four occupants with firearms involved in theft of motor vehicles.
- Blue Toyota Tazz with four occupants involved in theft out of motor vehicles.

#### **Extra operations conducted for Operation Duty Call (festive season):**

A shebeen operation was held in sector 1, where three unlicensed premises were closed and three people arrested for selling liquor without licenses and liquor was confiscated and handed in at the police station.

On the 25<sup>th</sup> of October there was a shebeen operation, where pubs and liquor outlets were inspected in sector 3, 4 and 6. A stern warning is used to all owners of liquor outlets, pubs and shebeens to ensure that their licenses are in order.

On the 27<sup>th</sup> of October a greenbelt operation was conducted in conjunction with JMPD, City Parks, Securitas, Gauteng Security, ADT and Londoloza. The following premises were cleaned:

- Radiokop greenbelts,
- Dumping site in Allen's Nek,
- Veld next to the Panorama sports ground.

Possible stolen goods were recovered and 23 people were arrested on bylaw infringements.

A high visibility operation was conducted on Friday, the 28<sup>th</sup> of October, throughout the Honeydew Precinct from 20:00 till 04:00. Various problematic premises were searched and "hotspot" greenbelts were swept.
