



Securitas Fights back...

Securitas Randburg made or assisted in making 62 arrests in the last week. This is a commendable achievement and shows our commitment to fighting crime in South Africa. We would like to thank our courageous Officers who were prepared in some cases to put their lives on the line to make these arrests so as to contribute to making our lives a little safer.

Operations were conducted with the SAPS - A joint operation was carried out with the SAPS in the Linden Precinct targeting hotspots for criminals in the area - during this Operation a total of 48 persons were arrested and taken to Linden Police Station for processing.

A further 13 Suspects were arrested from around the Northern suburbs of Johannesburg for house breaking, assault, theft and trespassing.

A particularly successful arrest following an Armed Robbery where a Securitas Reaction Officer responding to a client who phoned our Control Centre after he found 2 suspects on the premises busy packing the contents of his home into his wife's car. They had already tied up the elderly female resident and were about to attack her husband. Our Reaction Officer fired a warning shot and the suspects fled. After investigation it was discovered that one of our Officers manning the boom gate had seen the suspects leaving the area. He said he regularly saw these suspects and they normally entered the area through his boom. The boom was staked out the following morning and these suspects returned and were promptly arrested. Taken into custody by Linden SAPS.

We would also like to thank the SAPS who often are unheralded in their efforts to fight crime, but are an important partner for Securitas when fighting crime.

Securitas would like to recognise our staff members for their efforts and hold them up as a positive example that Securitas has a Zero Tolerance attitude towards criminal activities and will do all within our power to fight crime in South Africa.
